

INVITATION FOR BIDS

THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG is requesting sealed bids for the "A RE-BID OF THE PROJECT, VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK, ADDITION OF SIX GRANITE NAMING PANELS, RIVERSIDE DRIVE, NEAR EDISTO MEMORIAL GARDENS, ORANGEBURG, SOUTH CAROLINA".

Bids for this construction will be received on Wednesday February 16 at 3:00 P.M at Orangeburg City Council Building, 933 Middleton Street, adjacent to City Hall, Orangeburg, South Carolina at which time and place bids will be publicly received. Late bids will not be accepted.

The contract documents have been prepared by SUMMERS & ASSOCIATES ARCHITECTS, AIA, 1540 Russell Street SE, Orangeburg, South Carolina 29115. These documents may be examined in the office of the Architects.

General Contractors duly licensed in South Carolina may obtain plans and specifications (contract documents) from the Architects by requesting in writing and depositing \$100.00 for the each set of which \$50.00 is refundable to bona fide bidders returning plans and specifications in good condition within 10 days from the bid date. All other deposits shall be forfeited.

Sub-Contractors and material suppliers may purchase copies of the plans and specifications (contract documents) from the Architects, upon written request, at the cost of reproduction, handling and mailing. Payments for these plans and specifications will not be refundable.

Each bidder to be considered must be legally licensed under the laws and regulations of the State of South Carolina. Bids must comply with all the conditions of the specifications, and ordinances of City of Orangeburg, made on the form provided and enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, his bidders license number and his general contractor's license number and marked: PROPOSAL - "A RE-BID OF THE PROJECT, VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK, ADDITION OF SIX NAMING PANELS, RIVERSIDE DRIVE, ORANGEBURG, SOUTH CAROLINA".

No bids may be withdrawn for a period of forty five (45) days subsequent to opening bids without the written consent of the Owner. A five per cent (5%) bid bond or certified check in the amount of 5% of the BID will be required. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a 100% Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any formalities in the bidding, and to award a contract on any part of the work to his best interest.
